

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 13th day of April, 2015 at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Mayor Zem Hopkins, Councilwoman Kelly Blue, Councilman Brian Burg, Councilman James Burnett, Councilman Robert Reetz, Councilman Eric Rudy and Councilwoman Kate Zimmerman.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to approve the agenda for April 13, 2015 as amended; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council.

OLD BUSINESS:

(1) Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to pass, approve and adopt on Third Reading Ordinance No. 2015-842 - Sanitation Processes; seconded by Councilwoman Blue and unanimously approved by Council.

NEW BUSINESS:

(1) Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to pass, approve and adopt Resolution No. 2015-705 - Sanitation Rates; seconded by Councilman Rudy. Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to amend the resolution item #3 to one time charge of \$15 and \$30; seconded by Councilwoman Blue. The Mayor then called for the motion. Those voting "Aye" - Councilwoman Blue, Councilman Burnett, Councilwoman Zimmerman, Councilman Rudy and Councilman Reetz. Those voting "Nay" - Councilman Burg and Mayor Hopkins. Motion carried. The question was then called on the motion as amended. All in favor.

(2) The city staff was Instructed to get numbers on leasing a street sweeper.

(3) Motion was made by Councilman Burnett to approve the submittal for grant funding through the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program; seconded by Councilman Reetz and unanimously approved by Council.

(5) Councilman Burg left the meeting at this point. Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to award the bids for items to the highest bidders; seconded by Council Reetz and unanimously approved by Council present. Councilman Burg then returned to the meeting.

(1) Comments were made by Councilwoman Blue, Councilman Burg, Councilman Burnett, Councilman Reetz, Councilman Rudy and Councilwoman Zimmerman.

(2) Mayor presented his comments.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to recess the regular meetings and convene into Executive Session to discuss personnel and pending litigation; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council, 8:38 p.m.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to reconvene the regular meeting; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council; 9:26 p.m.

There being no further business before Council, motion was made by Councilwoman Blue the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council, 9:37 p.m.
