

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 30th day of November, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present on roll call were Councilwoman Kelly Blue, Councilman Brian Burg, Mayor Zem Hopkins, Councilman Robert Reetz and Councilwoman Kate Zimmerman. Councilman James Burnett and Councilman Eric Rudy were absent.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to unexcuse the absence of Councilman Burnett and Councilman Rudy; seconded by Councilman Burg. The vote was then called for. Those voting “Yea” were Councilman Burg, Councilman Reetz, and Councilwoman Zimmerman. Those voting “Nay” were Councilwoman Blue. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to approve the agenda for November 30, 2015 as amended; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.

- (3) Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to approve the Personal Trainer Contract with Arion Tully; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman and unanimously approved by Council present.
- (4) Motion was made by Councilman Burg to reject any and all bids for the Rec Center Re-Roof; seconded by Councilwoman Blue and unanimously approved by Council present.
- (5) Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to approve the ordinance proposed in section 5-30 and sequential numbers regarding the keeping of chickens; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman and Councilman Reetz. Mike Lundgren, Karen Lundgren, David Crosland, Jason Despain and Heidi Despain spoke on behalf of this agenda item. The mayor then called for the vote. Those voting "Yea" were Councilwoman Blue, Councilman Burg, Councilman Reetz, and Councilwoman Zimmerman. Mayor Hopkins voted "Nay." Motion carried.
- (6) Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to authorize the mayor to sign the contract for the acceptance of funds from the Homeland Security Grant; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.
- (7) Motion was made by Councilwoman Blue to authorize the Chief of Police to sign the contract for the acceptance of funds from the Highway Safety Funding Grant; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.
