

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2015, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Mayor called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Mayor Zem Hopkins, Councilman Brian Burg, Councilman James Burnett, Councilman Robert Reetz, Councilman Eric Rudy and Councilwoman Kate Zimmerman. Absent was Councilwoman Kelly Blue.

Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to unexcuse the absence of Councilwoman Blue; seconded by Councilman Burg. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" - Mayor Hopkins, Councilman Burg, Councilman Reetz, Councilman Rudy and Councilwoman Zimmerman. Those voting "Nay" - Councilman Burnett. Motion carried.

  - (9) Motion was made by Councilman Burnett to approve the lease renewal at the Old Town Hall with Kelly Blue; seconded by Councilman Rudy and unanimously approved by Council present.
  - (10) Motion was made by Councilman Burnett to authorize the application for WAM-WCCA Energy Lease Program for a new boiler at the outdoor pool; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman and unanimously approved by Council present.
  - (11) Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to authorize submission of the Kemmerer Foundation Grant Request; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman and unanimously approved by Council present.
  - (12) Councilman Burg recused himself at this time. Motion was made by Councilman Rudy to accept Andy Burg as the at-large member for the Kemmerer-Diamondville Water and

Wastewater Joint Powers Board; seconded by Councilman Reetz and unanimously approved by Council present. Councilman Burg returned to the meeting at this time.
