Motion was made by Councilwoman Zimmerman to approve the agenda for May 23, 2016 as presented; seconded by Councilman Rudy and unanimously approved by Council.

- (3) City staff was directed to incorporate Option #3 as presented into the proposed Budget for FY 16-17 and to bring that budget back to council for the June 13 public hearing.
