

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 11th day of July, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present on roll call were Councilman Robert Bowen, Councilman Brian Burg, Mayor Zem Hopkins, Councilman Robert Reetz, Councilman Eric Rudy and Councilwoman Kate Zimmerman. Absent was Councilman James Burnett.

Motion was made by Councilman Burg to unexcuse the absence of Councilman Burnett; seconded by Councilman Rudy. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting “Yea” – Councilman Burg, Mayor Hopkins, Councilman Reetz, Councilman Rudy and Councilwoman Zimmerman. Those voting “Nay” - Councilman Bowen. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Zimmerman to approve the agenda for July 11, 2016 as presented; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.

- (2) Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to authorize the Mayor to sign the letter in support of the TAP Grant for Lincoln County; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" – Councilman Bowen, Councilman Reetz, Councilman Rudy and Councilwoman Zimmerman. Those voting "Nay" - Councilman Burg and Mayor Hopkins. Motion carried.
- (3) Motion was made by Councilwoman Zimmerman to authorize the Mayor to sign the MOU between Wyoming Business Council, City of Kemmerer and Kemmerer Main Street; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.
- (4) No motion was made as the council directed staff to arrange for the Utah Ballroom Dance Company to perform in the Kemmerer schools the week of September 19-23, 2016.
- (5) Motion was made by Councilman Reetz to authorize the Mayor to sign the two amended quit claim deeds to: Frank J. Kalan, Sylvia C. Kalan and Lynn C. Kalan and Ann Taylor; seconded by Councilman Burg and unanimously approved by Council present.
- (6) No motion was made as the council recommended staff take the policy to the Kemmerer Zoning Board first.

- (2) Mayor Hopkins presented his comments.
