



How important is the quality of streets to you?





Rec center needs more attention paid to it. New updated equipment, better hours. There is plenty of grant money out there for such things.

Snow removal this winter was excellent, especially with the high amounts of snow. Roads are in horrendous shape and must be replaced SOON!

Use a national provider for better, more comprehensive garbage service. Snow plowing needs to happen on every street. Not plowing some is also a safety issue where ambulances etc. cannot get through. People on short streets pay taxes too! Get someone in the events center that can sell it and make it self sustaining or shut it down. Using tax dollars to pay for entertainment to come to town is not a function of city government. Those should be provided by the arts council or similar entities. Close down the Fossil Basin Promotion Board and put that money back in the city. That money is being used poorly and not gaining anything for the community.

Streets are in desperate need

Doing fine with what resources they have

Streets are the primary function of the city (water & sewer should also be but we have the JPB). Way too much investment in police, municipal court and planning. Golf course, rec center, events center, outdoor pool, walking trails, parks, etc. are all very nice, however, citizens need info (true and accurate) on what they cost both in capital and maintenance. If there is a downturn, it may be necessary to cut some things. The events center appears to have minimal demand as a training center—do something to fix it so industry will use it, or find an alternate use (i.e. get it off your books!). I believe the walking trails and some of the parks are the best return on investment as far as use. Golf and the rec center are items which most people expect to pay for.

Archie Neal park is horribly maintained. The picnic tables are disgusting and people are very disinclined to use them for hygiene purposes. The outdoor pool is great for the kids who swim in it; however, those supervising the swimmers have a pathetic area in which to sit. Why hasn't the concession stand been utilized? Why not lease it out to an interested party (not the city government) to run, at a fair price? How about maintaining the grass so one does not require steel toed boots to walk on it? And while the caboose in the park is historic and fun to see, if it cannot be fixed and made safe for children to enjoy, it should be removed.

How could businesses be encouraged to clean up and beautify their store front areas? Why haven't the condemned buildings around the triangle been fixed or torn down? The moldy newspapers in the front windows are atrocious. Instead of a quaint, historic downtown area, the city gives off a very "ghetto" vibe to visitors. Everything seems closed and vacant. We have a plethora of crafty stores. Kemmerer should seriously consider what new businesses it could encourage. Ridley's Supermarket is a very sad grocery store. We need some competition that would encourage decent customer service as well as cleanliness and product quality.




Do you live within the municipal boundary of the City of Kemmerer?














Including yourself, how many people live in your household?


