

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2017 at 6 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Mayor Anthony Tomassi, Councilman Robert Bowen, Councilman David Crosland, Councilman Eric Rudy and Councilwoman Kate Zimmerman. Absent was Councilman David McGinnis.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Zimmerman to excuse the absence of Councilman McGinnis; seconded by Councilman Bowen and approved by Council present with Mayor Tomassi voting "Nay".

Motion was made by Councilman Bowen to approve the agenda for November 13, 2017 as amended; seconded by Councilwoman Zimmerman and unanimously approved by Council present.
