

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2019, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Motion was made by Councilman Bowen to approve the agenda for April 22, 2019 as amended; seconded by Councilman McGinnis and unanimously approved by Council.

Motion was made by Councilman McGinnis to support WAM Resolution No. 19-05; seconded by Councilman Chamberlain. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" – Mayor Tomassi, Councilman Bowen, Councilman Crosland, Councilman McGinnis, Councilman Chamberlain and Councilman Rudy. Those voting "Nay" – Councilman Quinn. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilman Chamberlain to support WAM Resolution No. 19-06; seconded by Councilman Quinn. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" – Mayor Tomassi, Councilman McGinnis, Councilman Chamberlain, Councilman Rudy and Councilman Quinn. Those voting "Nay" – Councilman Bowen and Councilman Crosland. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilman Bowen to support WAM Resolution No. 19-07; seconded by Councilman McGinnis. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" – Mayor Tomassi, Councilman McGinnis, Councilman Rudy and Councilman Quinn. Those voting "Nay" – Councilman Bowen, Councilman Crosland and Councilman Chamberlain. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilman McGinnis to support WAM Resolution No. 19-08; seconded by Councilman Chamberlain and unanimously approved by Council present.
