

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 10th day of June, 2019, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present on roll call were Mayor Anthony Tomassi, Councilman Robert Bowen, Councilman Dave McGinnis, and Councilman Eric Rudy. Councilman Vance Chamberlain, Councilman David Crosland, and Councilman Mark Quinn were absent.

Motion was made by Councilman Bowen to excuse the absence of Councilman Chamberlain and un-excuse the absence of Councilman Crosland and Councilman Quinn; seconded by Councilman Rudy. The Mayor then called for the question. Those voting “Yea” - Councilman Bowen and Councilman Rudy. Those voting “Nay” – Mayor Tomassi and Councilman McGinnis. Motion died.
