

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 10th day of February, 2020, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Mayor Anthony Tomassi, Councilman Mark Quinn, Councilman Eric Rudy, and Councilman John Sawaya. Councilman Robert Bowen was absent.

Motion was made by Councilman Quinn to excuse the absence of Councilman Bowen, seconded by Councilman Sawaya. The mayor then called for the question. Those voting “Yea” were Councilman Quinn, Councilman Rudy and Councilman Sawaya. Mayor Tomassi voted “Nay.” Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilman Sawaya to approve the agenda of February 10, 2020, as presented; seconded by Councilman Rudy and unanimously approved by Council present.

- (a) Motion was made by Councilman Quinn to Pass, Approve and Adopt on Third Reading Ordinance No. 2020-862, Weapons, as presented; seconded by Councilman Rudy and unanimously approved by Council present.

NEW BUSINESS:

- (a) Motion was made by Councilman Sawaya to approve JUB Change Order #2 to swap out filter on Jet A fuel dispensing system; seconded by Councilman Rudy and unanimously approved by Council present.

COMMENTS:

City Administrator Brian Muir commended staff and the community for their snow removal efforts. He stated that the public works department, law enforcement and staff have done a good job at helping communicate with the public. He mentioned that the snow has put a strain on snow removal equipment; however, staff continues to remove snow.

Councilman Rudy thanked the street department for snow removal efforts.

Councilman Quinn commended the efforts of snow removal. He mentioned how parts of town were inaccessible and staff got streets open in a commendable time frame. He noted that the public assistance calls with the police department were up and commended the police department on helping assist the community.

Councilman Sawaya commented on the tremendous job the community is doing of cleaning sidewalks and showing civic pride. It helps when people are out walking.

Mayor Tomassi said the public works department is doing a good job. He is hoping for a break in the weather as both snow blowers are currently down. Chad Nielson is hoping to have them up and running in the next day or so. He stated that for the most part citizens comments

regarding snow removal have been positive. He commented on the increase in events at the Event Center and hopes to see that trend continue.

There being no further business before Council, motion was made by Councilman Sawaya the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Councilman Quinn and unanimously approved by Council present; 7:23 p.m.
