- (a) Motion was made by Councilman Bowen to Pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No. 2020-863. Amending Section 2 and Section 8 of the Kemmerer City Code Regarding Elective Officers and Election Ward Boundaries; seconded by Councilman Thek. Councilman Bowen amended his motion to amend Section 2-47(b) setting the mayor's salary to be "no more than Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) per year."; amend section 2-47(c) to read "The Mayor's salary shall be Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) per month."; and amend the term councilman and councilmen to be gender neutral and be called out as council member throughout Section 2 and Section 8; seconded by Councilman Thek and unanimously approved by Council. The Mayor than called for the question on the original motion and it was unanimously approved by Council.
