

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 28th day of February, 2022, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Motion was made by Councilmember Thornock to approve the agenda as amended to add New Item (g), Support of an additional District Court Judge in Lincoln County; seconded by Councilmember Hicks and unanimously approved by Council.

Councilmember Rudy recused himself from the meeting, 7:58 p.m.

- (a) Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to approve the Personal Training Agreement with J & A Wellness, Jenee Rudy, for a term of 6 months, seconded by Councilmember Quinn and unanimously approved by council present.

Councilmember Rudy rejoined the meeting, 8:01 p.m.

- (b) Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to renew the contract with ALSOCO for SLTEC for the term of 24 months; seconded by Councilmember Price and unanimously approved by council.
- (c) Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to Pass, Approve and Adopt Resolution No. 2022-795, Replacing Resolution No. 2022-743 Setting SLTEC Policies and Procedures; seconded by Councilmember Thornock and unanimously approved by council.
- (d) Motion was made by Councilmember Quinn to authorize staff to move forward with the South Lincoln County Economic Liaison position to include the refinement of the job description and draft a contract for an amount not to exceed \$30,000 per year.; seconded by Councilmember Bowen. The mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea" were Mayor Thek, Councilmember Bowen, Councilmember Price, Councilmember Quinn and Councilmember Rudy. Councilmember Thornock voted "Nay." Motion carried.
- (e) Motion was made by Councilmember Price to approve the two-year Contract for Audit Services with Jones Simkins for an amount not to exceed \$21,250 per year; seconded by Councilmember Hicks and unanimously approved by council.
- (f) Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to approve JUB to go forward with going out to bid for the Kemmerer Airport SRE Building; seconded by Councilmember Bowen and unanimously approved by council.
- (g) Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to authorize the mayor to initiate an email to the Wyoming Legislature in support of an additional Circuit Court Judge for Lincoln County; seconded by Councilmember Rudy and unanimously approved by council.

There being no further business before the Council, Councilmember Hicks made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Councilmember Quinn and unanimously approved

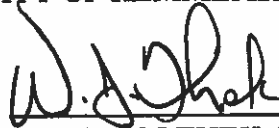

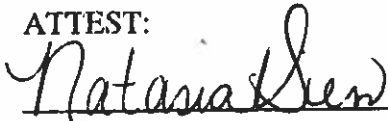
