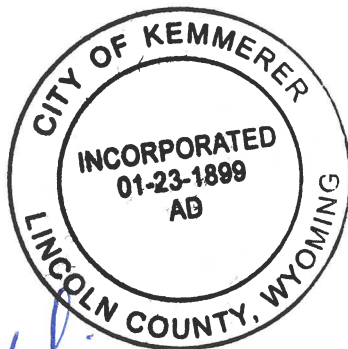
**NEW BUSINESS:**
