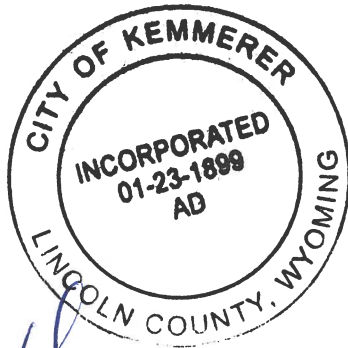
NEW BUSINESS:
