Roles and responsibility training was provided to council and staff by former WAM attorney, Mark Harris.

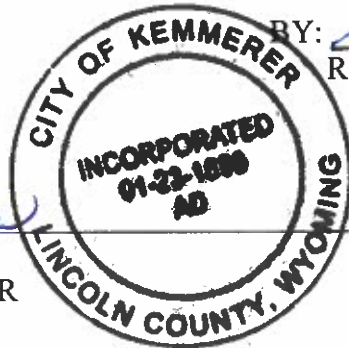
